

## Pella Cooperative Electric Scholarship Rules and Instructions for \$1,000 Scholarship Award

- 1. There will be no discrimination on the basis of age, sex, race, national origin, creed, religion, marital status or disability.
- 2. The recipient shall be a graduating high school senior in the 2021-2022 school year (August May) from any of the following school districts: Grinnell, Knoxville, Lynnville-Sully, Newton, North Mahaska, PCM, Twin Cedars or home schooled. One scholarship will be awarded per school and one home-schooled student. Pella High School and Pella Christian High School should apply for the opportunity to win a scholarship through the Pella Dollars for Scholars program.
- 3. The recipient shall be a U.S. citizen living in a home currently served by Pella Cooperative Electric (if a minor, his/her parents/quardians must be members).
- 4. All applications shall be completed in full and filed with Pella Cooperative Electric's Evaluation Committee after the applicant has completed three and one half years, or the equivalent in hourly credits, of high school. **Incomplete applications will not be** considered.
- 5. The applicant shall furnish a transcript showing three and one half years of high school grades, or the equivalent in hourly credits. All transcripts shall be retained by the Evaluation Committee whether or not the applicant is granted a scholarship. All information supplied by the applicants will be considered confidential.
- 6. Applicant must carry a minimum 3.0 grade point average.
- 7. Applications and Character Evaluations and Recommendation Form must be received in the Pella Cooperative Electric Office no later than **April 29**, **2022**.
- 8. Selection of scholarship recipients will be made after review of all completed applications by the Evaluation Committee of Pella Cooperative Electric.
- 9. A scholarship check will be made payable to the financial office of the educational institution. The scholarship recipient is responsible for providing correct mailing and student account identification information.
- 10. Scholarships will be paid in one installment (August).
- 11. Application will be considered complete when the following items are received:
  - a. Completed Application Form
  - b. High School Transcript
  - c. Personal Letter
  - d. Cover Letter Answering the Question: Why Are Electric Cooperatives Important?
  - e. Completed "Character Evaluation and Recommendation Form" (submitted separately by the applicant's reference)

- 3. A personal letter one page, typed, double spaced stating your educational goals, work and personal experiences, and any special circumstances surrounding the application that you feel the scholarship evaluation committee should consider.
- 4. A cover letter answering the following question: **Why are electric cooperatives important?**Please limit your answer to one paragraph (5-8 lines). Include your name, age, current grade in high school, high school name, home address, home phone number, cell phone number and email (if applicable).
- 5. Include a current photo to be used by the cooperative for publication purposes.

Pella Cooperative Electric **must receive** a completed "Character Evaluation and Recommendation Form" **before April 29, 2022**. A scholarship application is considered complete upon receipt of the application packet and character evaluation form (submitted separately by your reference). The character evaluation form must be mailed by your reference to:

All information supplied by the applicants will be considered confidential. The completed application and accompanying material will be retained by the Evaluation Committee as a permanent record of the applicant. *Only complete applications will be considered for the award.* 

Applicants will be evaluated based upon their personal letter and their answer to the question "Why are cooperatives important?" Evaluation will also be based upon the scholastic effort, extra-curricular activity participation and personal recommendations.
